

HISTORY OF GCAC

The Gulf Coast Athletic Conference developed out of a series of meetings held over a period of almost four years. A number of private four-year schools in the Gulf Coast region with similar educational standards, enrollments, budgets, and athletic philosophies mutually felt the need for a conference.

In April and May, 1981, a constitution was developed, officers were elected, and the decision was made to proceed with conference competition in men's and women's basketball, baseball, and men's tennis during the 1981-82 school year. Charter members were Belhaven College of Jackson, Mississippi; Dillard University of New Orleans, Louisiana; Louisiana College of Pineville, Louisiana; Spring Hill College of Mobile, Alabama; Tougaloo College of Tougaloo, Mississippi; William Carey College of Hattiesburg, Mississippi; and Xavier University of New Orleans, Louisiana, In August, 1981, the GCAC received recognition as a National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics affiliated conference. All conference members are also members of NAIA District 30.

NAIA POLICIES

All GCAC members are also members of the National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics and of NAIA District 30. The GCAC is an NAIA Affiliated Conference. Accordingly, all member schools are bound by NAIA policies as stated in the NAIA Official Handbook. A summary of some important items and deadlines to remember follows.

All members are required to submit to the NAIA National Office and the District 30 Chairman, Dr. James C. Coleman, Tougaloo College, a declaration of intent to participate—or not to participate—in Men's Football, Soccer, Basketball and Baseball and Women's Basketball, Softball, and Volleyball. Deadlines for filing for Football, Soccer and Volleyball is September 15; for Basketball, December 1; and for Baseball and Softball, March 1. Delinquent filing of intent to participate certificate results in ineligibility to participate in NAIA District and National Championship events for the sports in which filing was delinquent. (See NAIA Handbook, pp. 27, 44-45)

The faculty athletic representative of each institution is required to check the eligibility of each athlete prior to participation and to file with the District 30 Eligibility Chairman, Dr. Thomas Howell, Louisiana College, official forms signed by the registrar, athletic director, and faculty athletic representative containing the names of all players eligible to participate in the sportiin season. Reports become delinquent if not postmarked by October 15 for Fall sports (includes Soccer and Volleyball, Fall Baseball, Golf, Tennis, etc.); by February 1 for Winter sports (includes Basketball); and by April 15 for Spring sports (includes Baseball, Softball, Track, Tennis, and Golf). Delinquency in filing eligibility certificates results in ineligibility to participate in post-season events in the delinquent sport, participation in other sports withheld, and possible censure.
